Construction

Aluminum

Less than 0.1% copper content - Marine Grade 6060 extruded & LM6 Aluminum High Pressure die casting provides excellent mechanical strength, clean detailed product lines and excellent heat dissipation.

Pre-paint

8 step degrease and phosphate process that includes deoxidizing and etching as well as a zinc and nickel phosphate process before product painting.

Memory Retentive -Silicon Gasket

Provided with special injection molded "fit for purpose" long life high temperature memory retentive silicon gaskets. Maintains the gaskets exact profile and seal over years of use and compression.

Thermal management

LM6 Aluminum is used for its excellent mechanical strength and thermal dissipation properties in low and high ambient temperatures. The superior thermal heat sink design by Ligman used in conjunction with the driver, controls thermals below critical temperature range to ensure maximum luminous flux output, as well as providing long LED service life and ensuring less than 10% lumen depreciation at 50,000 hours.

Finishing

All Ligman products go through an extensive finishing process that includes fettling to improve paint adherence.

Paint

UV Stabilized 4.9Mil thick powder coat paint and baked at 200 Deg C. This process ensures that Ligman products can withstand harsh environments. Rated for use in natatoriums.

MicroPRIM™ is Ligman's trade marked decorative powder coating technology that permanently infuses colors, patterns, or imagery directly into the surface of luminaires and poles while providing protections that standard powder coating does not offer.

MicroPRIM finishes include nature-inspired wood grains and stone aesthetics, material-inspired finishes such as brushed metal, concrete, and carbon fiber. Solid colors in Ligman standard colors, as well as any RAL or Pantone color. Decorative patterns, custom imagery and more.

Coating and Infusion Process

Metal components are pre-treated and powder coated with a proprietary polyurethane-based coating engineered for outdoor architectural use. Decorative patterns or imagery are then permanently infused into the cured powder coat through a heat-based process, creating a durable, integrated finish.

Performance and Validation

MicroPRIM™ finishes are suitable for indoor and outdoor applications and meet AAMA 2605 architectural coating requirements. Performance is validated through laboratory and real-world testing to ASTM standards for UV exposure, adhesion, abrasion, impact, salt spray, chemical resistance, and graffiti resistance.

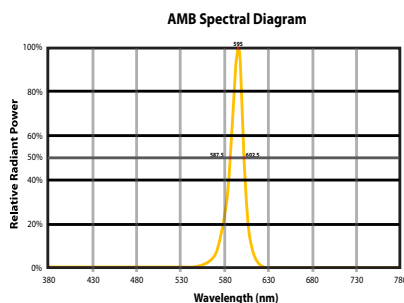

Required Wellington Pole Information

Additional pole information is required while using Wellington post top fixtures.

Ligman-Supplied Poles

Ligman provides poles specifically designed for this fixture.

Pole size, finish, and color will match the fixture exactly.

Competitive pricing is available through the Ligman Lighting USA Quotations Department.

Poles from other Manufacturers

Using poles from other manufacturers require additional information to ensure that Ligman's Tenon assembly will fit correctly.

Important Notes:

The gear tray is installed inside the pole and is connected to a Ligman-supplied tenon assembly.

The tenon assembly contains the power entry for the fixture.

Once the Pole Diameter and Thickness is Confirmed, the installer, customer or contractor must provide the illustration shown below to the pole manufacturer. This ensures that the tenon fastening holes are positioned correctly to accept the Ligman tenon assembly.
